2024 Priority Committee Summary & Transition to 2025 Reports

#1) Property Taxes: (Wayne/Rick)

Despite strong taxpayer attendance and protest at the RDN chambers of Dec.10th, the RDN BOD preliminarily approved the proposed 2025-29 Financial Plan. Final approval required by March 31st. Going forward, this less than satisfactory decision was considered only a temporary setback. The Committee will determine how individual RDN directors voted on this important matter and "work" them towards a better outcome. A fledgling RDN Taxpayer Alliance is evolving from other RDN resident associations sharing similar property tax concerns. Opportunities from such an alliance to be followed up and advised.

#2) Water: (Rudi/Neil/Gina)

RDN "Nanoose Bay Water Reservoir Improvement Project- Alternate Approval Process failed. Close monitoring of all water matters via RDN postings to occur.

#3) Beach Accesses:

File Now Held In Abeyance until Next Parks & Open Space Advisory("POSAC")Committee In 2025.

#4) Pools in Oceanside: ()

Ravensong Aquatic Centre ("RAC") now subject to a proposed \$36.4 expansion requiring a \$30.0m borrowing referendum. On Nov. 24yh, NNRA unanimously resolved to <u>NOT</u> support this borrowing referendum request, see Attachment #1 & supporting documentation.

Prototype for Board consideration not yet built. NNRA current cash resources has spawned confidence to "get'er done" by Jan 18th. Estimated budget for 9 signs \$1,800-\$2,000.
